



ERC Project, 'Jagiellonians: Dynasty, Memory & Identity'
Research assistant (Jagiellonian Prosopography)

The ERC Jagiellonians project is seeking to engage a short-term research assistant in Jagiellonian prosopography, to assist the Principal Investigator (PI), Dr. Natalia Nowakowska as she writes a new international history of the Jagiellonian dynasty (c.1386-1596). An ability to read Polish is essential. The research assistant would be required to work for up to 10 – 12 weeks full-time, with the tasks completed by September 2018. The work can be done from outside the UK.

The research assistant would, in consultation with the PI:

- Prepare a review essay on the latest advances & techniques in prosopography research.
- Design, and identify the best software for, a prosopography database of the Jagiellonian dynasty.
- Embark on data collection/populating of the database.

Candidates will have:

- Excellent reading knowledge of Polish; with other Central European languages also an advantage.
- A background in History
- Experience of working with history databases.
