



ERC Project, 'Jagiellonians: Dynasty, Memory & Identity'  
Research assistant (Mapping the Jagiellonians)  
(Reference: RA4Map)

The ERC Jagiellonians project is seeking to engage the services of a short-term research assistant to produce a series of dynamic maps, to assist the Principal Investigator (PI), Dr. Natalia Nowakowska as she writes a new international history of the Jagiellonian dynasty (c.1386-1596). The research assistant would each required to work for up to 10-12 weeks full-time, with the tasks completed by September 2018. The work can be done from outside the UK.

The research assistant would, in consultation with the PI:

- Write a review of recent advances in mapping the geographical movements of a group/individuals.
- Identify software and methods suitable for mapping the Jagiellonian dynasty.
- Using existing published 'itineraries' for Jagiellonian rulers and consorts, prepare a cutting edge set of maps, enabling spatial analysis of this dynasty.

Candidates will:

- Have a background in History
- Have experience of mapping software.
- Knowledge of Latin or Polish is an advantage, but not essential.
