



ERC Project, 'Jagiellonians: Dynasty, Memory & Identity'
Two research assistants (Lithuanian, Hungarian)
(Reference: RA1Lith, RA2Hung)

The ERC Jagiellonians project is seeking to engage the services of short-term research assistants (1 x Lithuanian, 1 x Hungarian) to assist the Principal Investigator (PI), Dr. Natalia Nowakowska, with research in these language areas as she writes a new international history of the Jagiellonian dynasty (c.1386-1596). The research assistants would each be required to work for up to 2 months full-time, with the tasks completed by September 2018. The work can be done from outside the UK.

The Research Assistants would

- In consultation with the PI, compile an annotated bibliography of the very latest historical research published on the Jagiellonian dynasty in Lithuanian / Hungarian.
- With the PI, identify the most significant or relevant of these contributions.
- Prepare summaries or translations of key articles/book chapters.

Candidates should have

- Proven experience of reading Lithuanian/ Hungarian in their own academic work.
- A background in historical research, preferably the late medieval / early modern period.

Please supply a covering letter, short CV, and the name and email address of one academic referee. Please indicate which your language specialism is, and whether you would be conducting this work in the UK or abroad.
