



ERC Project, 'Jagiellonians: Dynasty, Memory & Identity'
Research assistant (Turkish/Ottoman)

The ERC Jagiellonians project is seeking to engage the services of a short-term research assistant with excellent reading knowledge of modern and Ottoman Turkish, to assist the Principal Investigator (PI), Dr. Natalia Nowakowska, as she writes a new international history of the Jagiellonian dynasty (c.1386-1596). The research assistant would be required to work for up to 2 months full-time, with the tasks completed by September 2018. The work can be done from outside the UK.

The research assistant would, in consultation with the PI:

- Compile a bibliography of the latest research on Ottoman-Jagiellonian relations published in Turkish.
- Compile a bibliography of the key Ottoman sources on Ottoman-Jagiellonian relations (i.e. wars in Hungary/Poland, diplomacy, Transylvania, courtly contacts).
- Translate source extracts or key articles where required.

- Will have proven experience of reading Turkish scholarship & Ottoman sources in their academic work/ an academic context.
